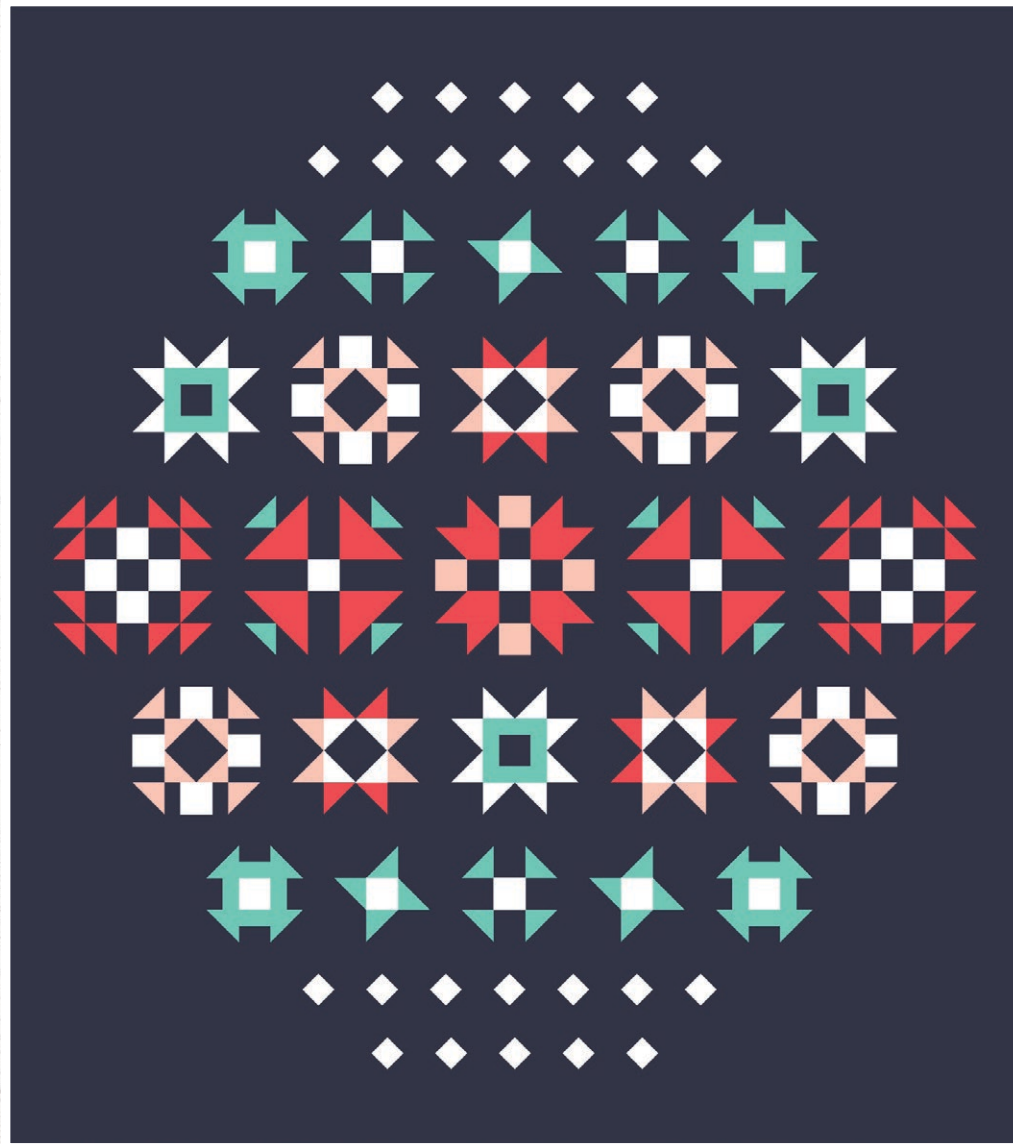

A companion pattern to the 2019 Hexie Snowflake Sampler incorporating the same blocks in an alternative pyramid style layout. The 2019 Quilter's Planner Magazine is required for this pattern.

PYRAMID LAYOUT

ABOUT THIS PATTERN

The pyramid layout is an alternative layout for the 2019 Hexie Snowflake sampler quilt from the 2019 Quilter's Planner Magazine. The same blocks are used in this pattern as the Hexie Snowflake quilt, just in different quantities.

The 2019 Quilter's Planner Magazine is required to make this pattern as all of the block instructions are in the magazine.

The quilt finishes at a lap size of 64 1/2" x 72 1/2". The pattern is written using blocks in specific placements, but feel free to rearrange or use different numbers of blocks within the rows.

PATTERN NOTES

Width of fabrics (WOF) is assumed to be at least 40". A scant 1/4" (a thread width smaller than 1/4") seam is to be used throughout the construction of the quilt unless otherwise instructed.

A coloring diagram of the quilt top is included on page 4 to audition possible color schemes and quilting motifs.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

Fabric A - 3/4 yard

Fabric B - 1/2 yard

Fabric C - 3/4 yard

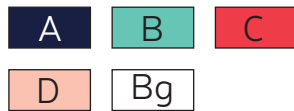
Fabric D - 1/2 yard

Bg fabric - 5 1/2 yards (approx. 2 yards bg within the blocks and 3 1/2 yards for bg outside of the blocks).

Binding fabric - 2/3 yard

Backing fabric - 4 1/2 yards

Batting - 73" x 81"



BLOCK CONSTRUCTION

Using the Hexie Snowflake Sampler quilt pattern on pages 15-21 in the 2019 Quilter's Planner Magazine, make the following blocks:

- 0 - Center Block (the center block is not used in this layout)
- 4 - Inner Ring Block 1
- 3 - Inner Ring Block 2
- 3 - Inner Ring Block 3
- 2 - Middle Ring Block 1

2 - Middle Ring Block 2

1 - Middle Ring Block 3

4 - Outer Ring Block 1

3 - Outer Ring Block 2

3 - Outer Ring Block 3

24 - Diamond Blocks

BG FABRIC CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut 1 strip 8 1/2" x WOF.
 - a. Sub-cut the strip into 4 squares 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".
2. Cut 4 strips 6 1/2" x WOF.
 - a. Sub-cut the strips into 4 rectangles 6 1/2" x 19 1/2" and 4 rectangles 6 1/2" x 13 1/2".
3. Cut 4 strips 5 1/2" x WOF.
4. Cut 1 strip 3 1/2" x WOF.
 - a. Sub-cut the strip into 2 rectangles 3 1/2" x 10 1/2".
5. Cut 22 strips 2 1/2" x WOF.
 - a. Sub-cut 2 strips into 2 rectangles 2 1/2" x 26 1/2".
 - b. Sub-cut 2 strips into 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 10 1/2".
 - c. Sub-cut 2 strips into 8 rectangles 2 1/2" x 8 1/2".
 - d. Sub-cut 2 strips into 8 rectangles 2 1/2" x 6 1/2".
 - e. Sub-cut 2 strips into 20 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" and 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".
 - f. Reserve remaining 12 strips.

ROW ASSEMBLY

For the row assemblies, press all seams open or away from the blocks.

Row 1

Sew together the following middle ring blocks 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" and bg fabric pieces to make a row 1 measuring 10 1/2" x 64 1/2".

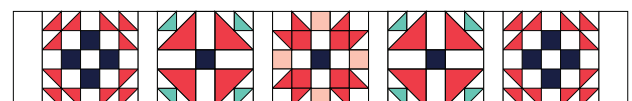
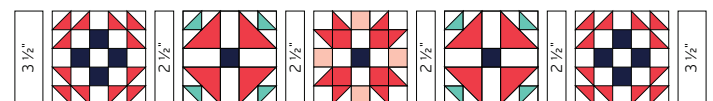
2 Middle Ring Block 1

2 Middle Ring Block 2

1 Middle Ring Block 3

4 bg fabric rectangles 2 1/2" x 10 1/2"

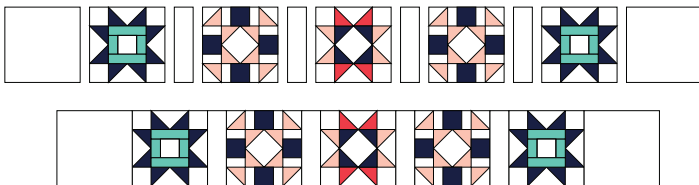
2 bg fabric rectangles 3 1/2" x 10 1/2"



Row 2A

Sew together the following inner ring blocks $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ and bg fabric pieces to make a row 2A measuring $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$.

- 2 Inner ring block 1
- 2 Inner ring block 2
- 1 Inner ring block 3
- 4 bg fabric rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$
- 2 bg fabric squares $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$

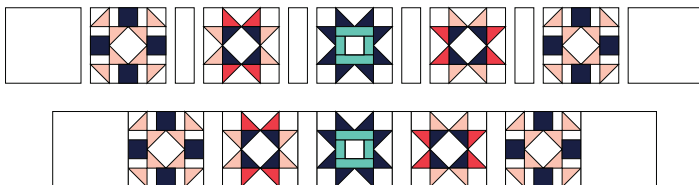


Row 2B

Row 2B is the same as Row 2A, excepting using different inner ring blocks.

Sew together the following inner ring blocks $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$ and bg fabric pieces to make a row 2B measuring $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$.

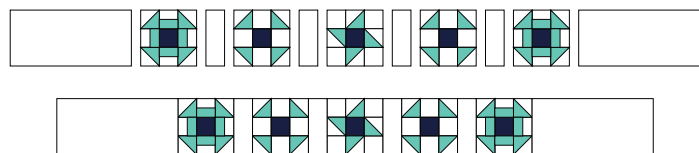
- 2 Inner ring block 1
- 1 Inner ring block 2
- 2 Inner ring block 3
- 4 bg fabric rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$
- 2 bg fabric squares $8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}"$



Row 3A

Sew together the following outer ring blocks $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ and bg fabric pieces to make a row 3A measuring $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$.

- 2 Outer ring block 1
- 2 Outer ring block 2
- 1 Outer ring block 3
- 4 bg fabric rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
- 2 bg fabric squares $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 13\frac{1}{2}"$

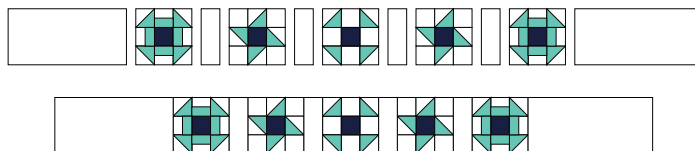


Row 3B

Row 3B is the same as Row 3A, excepting using different outer ring blocks.

Sew together the following outer ring blocks $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$ and bg fabric pieces to make a row 3B measuring $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$.

- 2 Outer ring block 1
- 1 Outer ring block 2
- 2 Outer ring block 3
- 4 bg fabric rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}"$
- 2 bg fabric squares $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 13\frac{1}{2}"$



Row 4

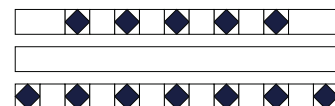
- Sew together 7 diamond blocks $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$ alternating with 6 bg fabric squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$.



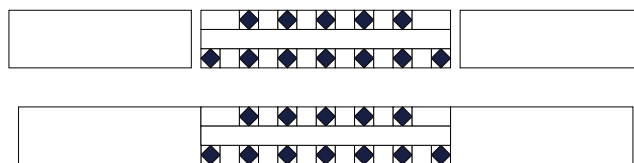
- Sew together 5 diamond blocks, 4 bg fabric squares $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{1}{2}"$, and 2 bg fabric rectangles $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$.



- Sew the unit from step 1, a bg fabric rectangle $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 26\frac{1}{2}"$, and the unit from step 2 together.



- Sew bg fabric rectangles $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 19\frac{1}{2}"$ onto the sides of the unit of step 3 to make a row 4 measuring $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$. Repeat to make a total of 2 Row 4.



Sashing Rows

Sew together 2 bg fabric strips $2\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ and trim to $64\frac{1}{2}"$ long to make a sashing row $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$. Repeat to make 6 sashing rows.

Borders

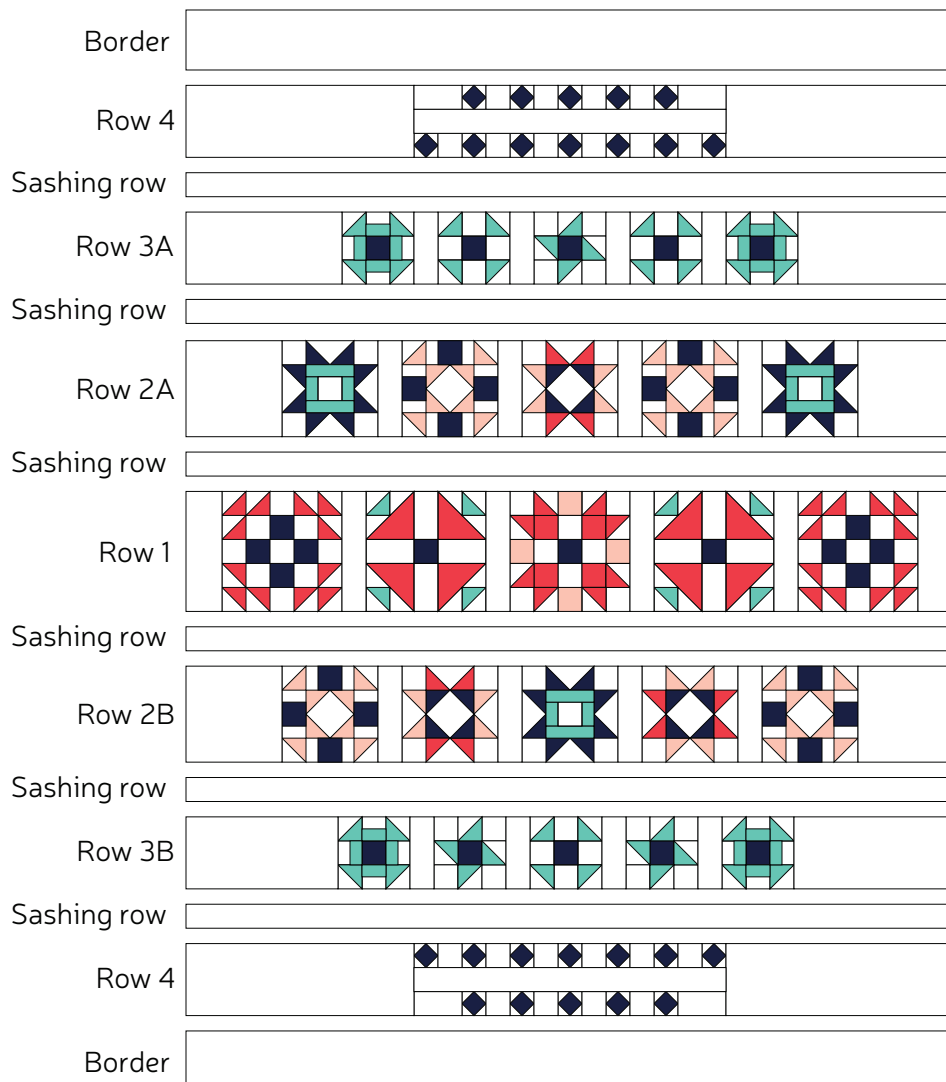
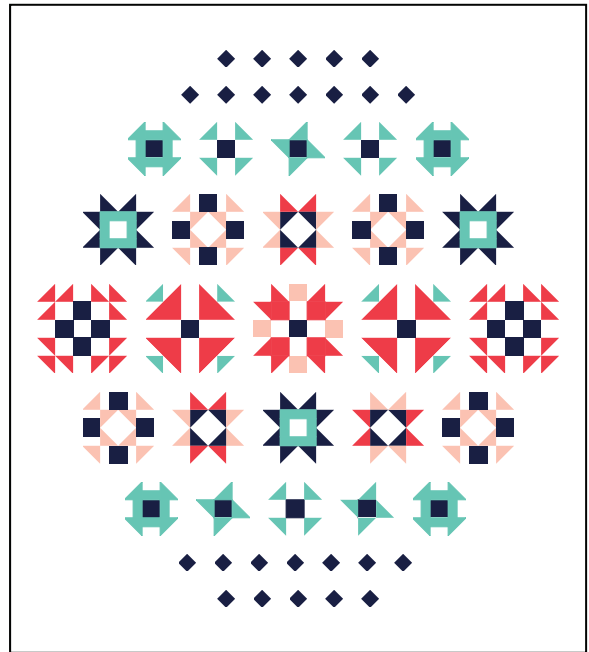
Sew together 2 bg fabric strips $5\frac{1}{2}" \times \text{WOF}$ and trim to $64\frac{1}{2}"$ long to make a border $5\frac{1}{2}" \times 64\frac{1}{2}"$. Repeat to make 2 borders.

QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY

Sew together the rows as shown below, pressing seams open or away from the rows with blocks. The quilt top should measure approx. 64½" x 72½".

FINISHING

1. Make quilt backing: Remove selvages, cut into 2 pieces (about 81" x WOF) and sew backing pieces together along the trimmed selvedge edges using a ½" seam, pressing seams open. Trim to approx. 73" x 81".
2. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste and quilt as desired.
3. Cut the binding fabric into 8 strips 2 ½" x WOF. Trim off selvages and sew together end-to-end to make the binding. Bind and enjoy your quilt!
